REQUEST FOR HIGH SCHOOL EARLY ADMISSION/DUAL CREDIT PROGRAM/ EARLY COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL

EARLY ADMISSIONS (EA) is the attendance of high school students (juniors and seniors) in college courses prior to graduation from high school. Early admissions students receive college level academic credit only for courses taken at EPCC. Courses may be taken during day, evening and weekend hours. Students are not eligible for financial aid.

HIGH SCHOOL DUAL CREDIT PROGRAM (DC) is a process by which an early admission student (junior or senior) enrolls in a college level course and receives simultaneous academic credit for the course from both the college and the high school. A formal program agreement between EPCC and the high school must exist for dual credit. Courses must be scheduled in advance by the high school. Courses for dual credit must be taken during the regular high school attendance hours. Students are not eligible for financial aid.

EARLY COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL (ECHS) program is a partnership between EPCC and area high school districts that offers students the opportunity to obtain an Associate of Arts degree as they graduate from high school. Early College High Schools are small schools designed so that in four years, students may earn both a high school diploma and an associate's degree or up to two years of credit toward a bachelor's degree.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Must be classified as a high school junior or senior for Early Admission or Dual Credit.
- 2. Early College High School requirements are determined by the different school districts.
- 3. Must meet academic placement assessment requirements in at least one area of mathematics, reading, and writing (students may only enroll in courses relating to areas of the test in which they place into college-level credit courses).
- 4. Enrollment in either EA, DC or combination is restricted to two (2) courses per semester.
